
Day 1 Curls of a returned child

CLAY MAKING IN HOTEL QUARANTINE

In late November 2020, with Melbourne out of lockdown, I rushed from a rural residency to meet with my fifteen-year-old son and guarantine in a Tullamarine hotel. He was returning from ten months exchange on a farm in rural Michigan, USA. In the frenzy, alarm, and uncertainty of this time, I grabbed whatever clay I had at home (slim pickings having been locked out of my studio for most of the year), a guitar, yoga mats, a 12-day stash of chocolate and met him at the airport gate lounge.

These were my Quarantine Residency Parameters:

- 1 Reacquaint myself as mother to my son
- 2 12 pieces of clay cut, wrapped and displayed on hotel windowsill
- 3 Make one sculptural object per day

- 4 Use food containers as display devices
- 5 Post daily on Instagram
- 6 Wait for time to expire
- 7 Exercise
- 8 Watch great movies
- 9 Hope that there are no other cases of COVID-19 in our hotel

I acknowledge that we are white, middle-class, citizens of Australia, giving my son a 'passport' to return to this country without challenge. We quarantined safely and in comfort. I had the luxury to turn this experience into an art residency. I am local and I am lucky.
